In return for One Tree Hill College finding and supervising a homestay for _____

1. I guarantee the acceptable behaviour of the student in New Zealand. I understand that unacceptable behaviour on the part of the student in the homestay may lead to the termination of the homestay and the student having to leave the school.
2. I understand that while in the care of One Tree Hill College, students must abide by New Zealand law, the rules and regulations of the school, host family and homestay rules.
3. In accordance with Immigration New Zealand regulations, students will not seek employment while holding a student visa unless they have a variation of conditions to their permit.
4. I understand the student will give at least two weeks notice to the Homestay Coordinator for One Tree Hill College before leaving the homestay. In addition I will pay for two weeks board, whether or not my son/daughter is in the home in the two-week notice period.
5. I understand that my son/daughter will not be permitted to leave homestay care without the written permission of their parent or guardian and the knowledge and permission of the Homestay Coordinator for One Tree Hill College.
6. I understand students under the age of 20 years are not permitted to own a car while attending One Tree Hill College unless strict procedures are followed. Students over 20 must see the International Office to get information regarding driving in New Zealand if they are considering buying a car.
7. I understand my son/daughter must have a comprehensive medical and travel insurance policy during their time in NZ. It is recommended that students choose a policy that will also cover the loss of personal items.
8. I understand that if any international calls are made from the premises of the homestay, the charges will be reversed to me. If they are not reverse calls, I guarantee to reimburse the homestay for any costs.
9. I will also reimburse any unpaid costs incurred by the student.
10. I understand that, if the student goes away on holiday for one week or more, they will pay \$70 per week as a holding fee for every week that they are away. This fee is for the storage of their belongings and the holding of the room. This payment shall be made in advance.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT TUITION AGREEMENT

This is an agreement between the parents or guardians of _____ and One Tree Hill College for the 2011 academic year.

1. One Tree Hill College agrees that:
 - a) It will provide tuition to the Student as requested providing that the student meets our admission conditions for the course.
 - b) Provide help, support and guidance to the student during their study at the school.
 - c) The school will use its best efforts to ensure the safety, health and well being of the Student while at One Tree Hill College.
 - d) The school will provide homestay accommodation, on request.
 - e) The school will use its best efforts to ensure that the homestay accommodation meets the student's needs.
 - f) The school will provide regular reports of the progress of the Student to the parents and the student's agent.
 - g) The school will observe and be bound by the Code of Practice for the pastoral care of International Students published by the Ministry of Education. Copies are available on request from the school or from the website: www.minedu.govt.nz
2. The Parents agree that:
 - a) The student is subject to the rules and regulations of One Tree Hill College and to the discipline provisions of the New Zealand Education Act 1989
 - b) The student is subject to the conditions of enrolment for International students, as set out in the prospectus and the application form of One Tree Hill College.
 - c) The student will follow any reasonable instruction given by a teacher.
 - d) They will provide the school with all academic and medical information about the student and any other information that could have an effect on the student's study and life in New Zealand. This includes notification of any learning disabilities.
 - e) The school can receive information from any other person about the student's medical, welfare or educational history.
 - f) The school can receive financial information about the student.
 - g) The school can use information about the student for educational, welfare and medical purposes.
 - h) The school can discuss information about the student with the student's homestay parents, or guardian, in the same way that the school would discuss such matters with the parents of a New Zealand student.
 - i) The school has the right to direct the student in their academic course and subject choices using their best judgement and experience.
 - j) The school has the authority to permit the student to participate in extra school activities and school trips.
 - k) The school has the authority to provide the necessary consents in the event of a medical emergency where it cannot reasonably contact the parents in the necessary time.
 - l) That the student will not own or drive a car while enrolled at One Tree Hill College unless they have followed the driving and car ownership procedures. That the student will not travel in a car driven by a driver who is unauthorized to drive under school policy or under New Zealand law.
 - m) That they will give written permission if their child intends to travel in New Zealand during holiday periods. The school reserves the right to override the parent's decision if the child's health and safety is at risk and there is inadequate supervision on the trip. Travel to destinations other than in New Zealand will be treated as for travel in New Zealand. Students fewer than 18 will not be allowed to travel unsupervised.
 - n) That they will ensure that their child will not extend holidays beyond the regulated dates.
 - o) That they will notify the school of any change of address or contact details.

3. All fees paid to the school are protected by the Fee Protection policy of One Tree Hill College.
4. Tuition Fees are subject to a refund policy. Information on this policy is in the information booklet.
5. While the school will do its best to ensure the safety, health and well being of the student, the school is not liable for any damage or harm caused to a student or to a student's property inside or outside of school hours.
6. The school's liability in relation to tuition services is limited to the amount of tuition fees paid by the student.
7. The student must have full and comprehensive health and medical insurance for their travel and Study periods.
8. The agreement may be terminated at any time by the parent or the school. The notice of termination must be in writing. If this agreement is terminated the refunds policy attached to this agreement shall apply.
9. This agreement is subject to the Consumer Guarantees Act 1993 and the Fair Trading Act.
10. Parents and Students have the right under the New Zealand Privacy Act to have access to any personal information about them that is held by the school. Parents and students can request corrections to any personal information held by the school.
11. Students' rights under the New Zealand Privacy Act allow them to ask for confidential help from health and guidance counsellors. This may include advice on contraception.
12. This agreement can be changed by the written agreement of parents and the school.
13. This agreement is made under New Zealand laws. The courts of New Zealand have exclusive jurisdiction.
