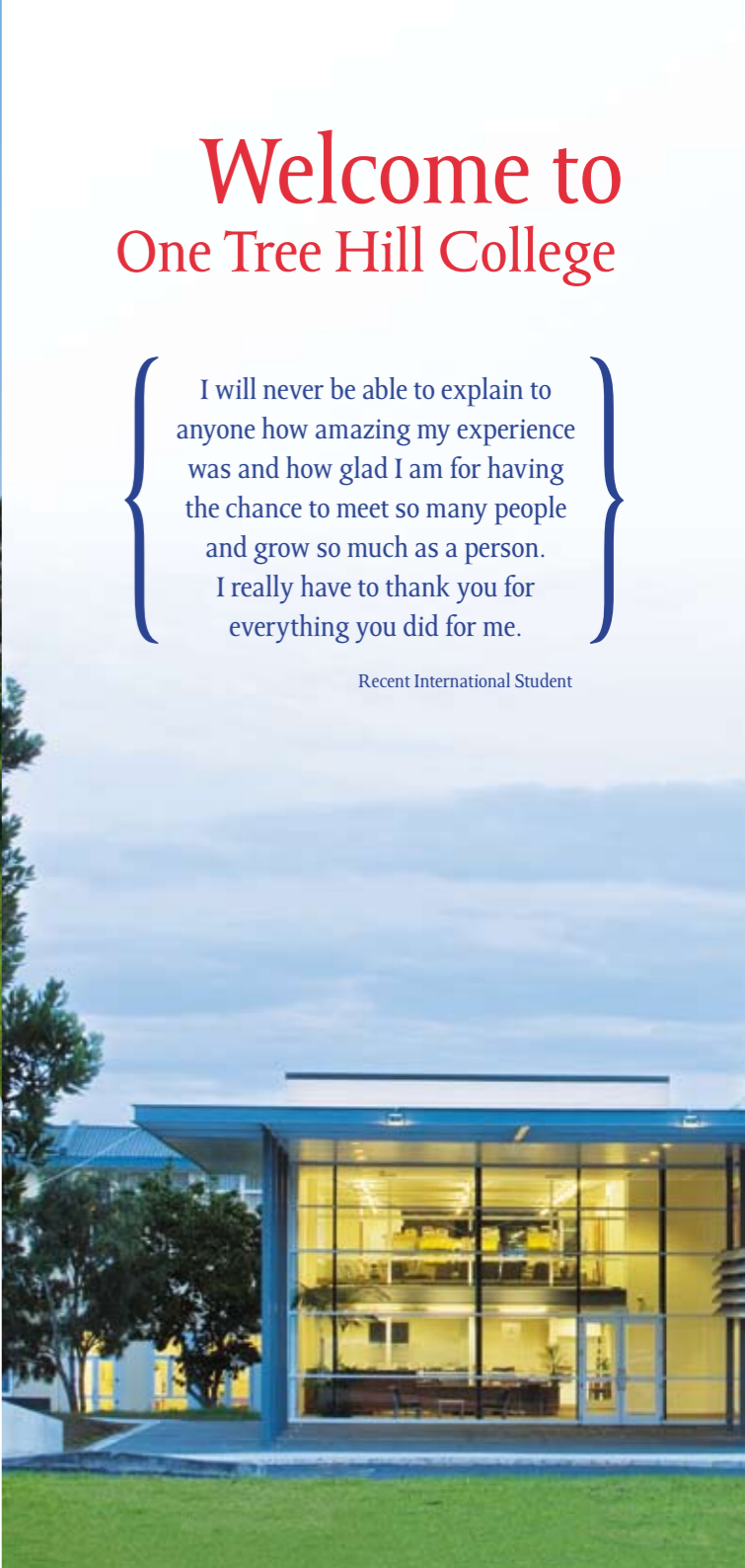

Enrolment

- Students are able to enrol for short or long term stays.

- There are no English language pre-requisites.
