Dear Parents and Caregivers

I would like to ask all parents and caregivers to ensure that they are aware of their child's programme for the remainder of the year to ensure no learning opportunities are missed. It is paramount that students are in their classes as much as possible to maximise their learning.

By now you should have received an email detailing information about our Parent/Teacher Interview Day next week which takes place on Thursday 1 August. It is important that every family books times to meet with their child's teachers, using the on-line booking system. 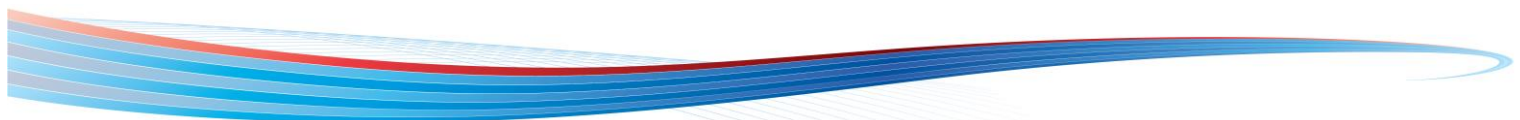
