ENROLMENT SCHEME

Home Zone

All students who live within the home zone described below* (and shown on the attached map) shall be entitled to enrol at the school.

Starting at the intersection of Green Lane East and Peach Parade, travel east towards and south along Ladies Mile (52, 47 and above included). Travel to and east along Abbots Way to and southeast along Lunn Ave (all addresses and side streets included) to and southeast along Ellerslie-Panmure Highway (Potaka Lane and all addresses on Mountain Road included; all side streets included) to Panmure roundabout. Follow the centre of Lagoon Drive (odd numbers only; 3-29 included) until you reach Panmure Bridge. Travel west across Panmure Basin and follow the coastline south to Bowden Road, east to and north along Carbine Road (87, 82 and below included) to South Eastern Highway. Follow the highway east to Great South Road (Mt Wellington Highway 393, 286 and above included). Travel south along Great South Road to the railway line (Sylvia Park Road excluded). Follow the railway line south west and west to the coastline. Follow the coastline to and north along Miami Parade to and west along Neilson Street to Captain Springs Road (excluded until Mays Road). Travel north along but east of Captain Springs Road to Mays Road (74, 77 and above included). Continue north along both sides of Captain Springs Road (198, 195 and above included) to Mt Smart Road. Travel east and north, but east of, Namata Road (excluded) to and west along Tawa Road (49, 50 and above included) to and north along, but east of, Moana Ave (not included) to Campbell Road. Cross over Campbell Road (86, 117 and above included) then follow around the western edge of Cornwall Park to Green Lane West (even numbers only; 200-170 included). Travel along the centre of Green Lane West and Green Lane East (even numbers only; 162-114 included) to the motorway. Continue east along, but south of, Green Lane East until you reach the starting point.

All no exit streets off included boundary roads are included

Proof of residence within the home zone will be required.

Each year, applications for enrolment in the following year from in-zone students will be sought by a date which will be published in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. This will enable the board to assess the number of places which can be made available to students who live outside the home zone.

Out of zone enrolments

Each year the board will determine the number of places which are likely to be available in the following year for the enrolment of students who live outside the home zone. The board will publish this information by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school. The notice will indicate how applications are to be made and will specify a date by which all applications must be received.

Applications for enrolment will be processed in the following order of priority:

<u>First Priority</u>	This priority category is not applicable at this school because the school does not run a special programme approved by the Secretary.
<u>Second Priority</u>	must be given to applicants who are siblings of current students.
<u>Third Priority</u>	must be given to applicants who are siblings of former students.
<u>Fourth Priority</u>	must be given to any applicant who is a child of a former student of the school.
<u>Fifth Priority</u>	must be given to any applicant who is either a child of an employee of the board of the school or a child of a member of the board of the school.
<u>Sixth priority</u>	must be given to all other applicants.

If there are more applicants in the second, third, fourth, or fifth priority groups than there are places available, selection within the priority group will be by a ballot conducted in accordance with instructions issued by the Secretary under Section 11G(1) of the Education Act 1989. Parents will be informed of the date of any ballot by notice in a daily or community newspaper circulating in the area served by the school.

Applicants seeking second or third priority status may be required to give proof of a sibling relationship.
