NCEA are yet to release the 2022 NCEA results. This will happen next week. I will report back to our community in my next newsletter the various successes of our students.

There have been a number of other student successes since my last newsletter. Some I am aware of include:

Benjamin Langley competed at the NZ Athletics Championships in December last year. He won the junior boys high jump, so is now the NZ Secondary Schools Junior Champion. As well as this, Ben was placed 2nd in the 300m hurdles, and 4th in the 100m hurdles. These are amazing achievements.

Courtney Matthews and **Lynnavie Tuisaula** have been selected for Netball NZ's National development camp being held this week. This is an elite group of New Zealand's best netball players from which the NZ Secondary Schools Team will be selected.

Angelica Vahai was the winner in the rugby category at the College Sport Auckland Young Sportsperson of the Year Awards. Like the Halberg Awards, they then named the overall winner. Angelica was named as one of the 7 overall finalists – this is a stunning achievement for our Dux Ludorum.

Luella Bracey was selected for the NZ Cricket's inaugural Pasifika Secondary School Girls Team, and trial for the under 19 Samoa Women's XI for the World Cup to be held in South Africa.

I am sure there are many other student successes which are yet to be reported. My congratulations to all students who have continued to perform at the highest level.
