Principal's Message



Dear Parents and Caregivers

As you may have heard in the media today, the PPTA have decided to escalate their industrial action from Monday 12 June. The major impact of this escalation is an increase of students being rostered home. This action is nationwide and is completely out of the control of Principals and Board of Trustees.

Commencing Monday 12 June, two year levels will be rostered home each day (Monday – Thursday). There is no rostering home on Fridays. The schedule for rostering home is below:

On the days noted above, students at the respective year levels are required to stay at home and not come to school. There may be some exceptions for some senior students who have NCEA assessments which must be completed on particular dates, this includes the numeracy and literacy assessments next week. In these cases, students (and

parents/caregivers) will get direct communication from their teacher or a senior leader.

I will keep you all updated as developments or changes come to hand. My hope is that the government and PPTA are able to reach a speedy resolution which reflects the hard work, expertise, and immense value that secondary school teachers add on a daily basis to young people in our schools.

Finally, I would like to congratulate Ms Sewter on her appointment as Hinau Whānau Leader. Ms Sewter will work alongside Mrs Keresoma to support the students in Hinau whānau.

OTHC 2024 YEAR 9 ENROLMENTS

All enrolments for 2024 will be governed under an enrolment scheme. Please refer to our website for more details and a map of the One Tree Hill College zone.

In Zone Enrolments:

All in zone students must apply for enrolment by submission of a fully completed online enrolment form and all required supplementary documentation <u>and</u> attend an interview on our special enrolment days on Wednesday 21 or Thursday 22 June 2023, 8am to 7pm. No appointments are required. All students must be with their parents/guardians and bring proof of ID (passport or birth certificate), latest school report and original proof of address (utility bill - power, water, rates are the only accepted proof of address).

Out of Zone Enrolments:

All out of zone students for 2024 must apply for enrolment by submission of a fully completed online enrolment form and all required supplementary documentation. No interview is required at this stage. The last day for out of zone online enrolments is Wednesday 30 August 2023. All out of zone enrolments are provisional until the ballot takes place on Wednesday 6 September 2023. All families will be contacted regarding the outcome of the ballot process.
