





CYBER SAFETY AGREEMENT

The One Tree Hill College computer network including high speed internet and fully wireless campus offer significant benefits to our teaching and learning programmes.

The purpose of this agreement is to ensure the safety of all users of the One Tree Hill College computer network including the use of the wireless network. The school promotes and maintains a cyber safety culture which is in line with the school values, legislative and professional obligations.

I understand that:

- The only purpose for school computers, network, and other Information Technology resources is to support teaching and classroom learning.
- I agree to only use ICT equipment under the direction of my teacher in class. This includes the use of mobile phones and other portable devices.
- I agree that whilst at school I will not have any involvement in the use of ICT which may put myself or others at risk. This includes cyber bullying and the inappropriate use of social media, for example, Facebook or Twitter.
- The school will do its best to keep me safe whilst using ICT. This includes monitoring and filtering of all data stored on or transferred using the school network.
- I understand that I am not permitted to access material through the Internet which is offensive, dangerous, inappropriate or illegal.
- I am forbidden to pass on such material by copying, storing or printing it. I will let my teacher know immediately if I accidentally access such material.
- If I use e-mail at school, I am not permitted to send any messages, which are offensive, dangerous, inappropriate or illegal.
- I understand that these rules apply to the use of all ICT equipment used at school. This includes laptops, tablets, phones and other storage devices.

I understand how important it is to:

- 1. Take care of Information Technology resources, such as computers, laptops, tablets and the Internet
 - a. Be careful with equipment and furniture.
 - b. Respect the copyrights on software that prohibit copying.

2. Be considerate of other users

- a. Share available equipment if required.
- b. Be careful not to waste computer resources e.g. paper.
- c. I will not intentionally disrupt the smooth running of any ICT equipment. This includes not attempting to hack or gain unauthorised access to any system.
- d. Take care not to scan or display graphics, record or play sounds, or type messages, which could cause offence to others.
- e. I will remove immediately from the screen any material that would not be allowed at the school, which I accidentally come across, and tell the teacher immediately.

3. Be responsible for privacy and security

- a. I will never share my passwords with any other students.
- b. I will not give anyone on the internet information about myself or anyone else this includes my address, phone number, photograph or credit card information.
- c. I will use external storage devices when given permission by my teacher to backup work or take it to and from home.
- d. I will tell the teacher if I come across a virus or security problem.

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT ACCOMMODATION AGREEMENT

(When placing a student in a School Approved Homestay)

Terms and Conditions:

For the purposes of this Agreement the following terms shall have the following meanings:

Accommodation means the residential accommodation provided to the Student pursuant to this Agreement.

Accommodation Requirements means the rules and requirements of the Accommodation as set out in Schedule One.

Agreement means this Accommodation Agreement between the Student, One Tree Hill College, and Parents which governs the Student's Accommodation arrangements.

Application Form means the standard enrolment application form.

Code means the Education (Pastoral Care of International Students) Code of Practice 2016 as updated from time to time and available online at www.legislation.govt.nz under Education (Pastoral Care of International Students) Code of Practice 2016.

Enrolment Agreement means the agreement between the Student, One Tree Hill College and the Parents which governs the Student's Tuition.

Homestay has the meaning as set out in the Code.

Parents means the Mother and Father referred to in the Application Form.

Residential Caregiver means the person responsible for the Student at the Accommodation.

Residential Caregiver Agreement means an agreement between One Tree Hill College and the Residential Caregiver.

School means the school referred to in the Application Form.

Student means the International Student residing at the Accommodation as referred to in the Application Form.

Tuition means the education of the Student at One Tree Hill College.

One Tree Hill College is a signatory to and complies with the Code. Every international student is required to reside at an Accommodation approved by One

Tree Hill College using the process set out in the Code.

- 2. The Parents and Student agree to adhere to the following terms and conditions of the Accommodation:
 - (a) One Tree Hill College agrees that all information regarding the Residential Caregiver, the Parents and the Student relating to the Accommodation will be kept confidential, except disclosure:
 - (i) To the Student, the Parents or Residential Caregiver (as the case may be);
 - (ii) To any professional consultant or such person where it is in the interests of the Student to provide the information;
 - (iii) Pursuant to any statutory or other legal duty.
 - (b) The Parents confirm that they have read and understood One Tree Hill College's refund policy. If the Parents provide misleading information or fail to disclose information about the Student One Tree Hill College may (in its sole discretion):
 - (i) Charge the Parent such fees as required to adequately compensate for additional requirements due to the lack of disclosure; or
 - (ii) Terminate this Agreement.
 - (c) The Parents agree that if behaviours or conditions of the Student emerge after placement with a Residential Caregiver such that the Residential Caregiver is unable to provide the level of accommodation or care required for the safety and wellbeing of the Student, One Tree Hill College may terminate this Agreement.
 - (d) The Parents or the Student have the right under the Privacy Act 1993 to obtain access to and request corrections of any personal information held by One Tree Hill College concerning them in relation to the Student's placement with a Residential Caregiver.
 - (e) Under the Privacy Act 1993, any information collected may be provided to education authorities.
 - (f) These terms and conditions may be varied by One Tree Hill College (acting reasonably) upon reasonable notification from time to time and will continue to apply until notified otherwise.

The initial appointment and ongoing engagement of the Residential Caregiver is subject at all times to:

 (a) the Residential Caregiver and One Tree Hill College entering into a Residential Caregiver Agreement; and (b) One Tree Hill College's usual requirements and policies in relation to the Accommodation.

One Tree Hill College will ensure that to the best of its ability:

- (a) The Accommodation provides a safe, positive and healthy environment for the Student and complies with the Code;
- (b) The Residential Caregiver's appointment has not involved any form of gift (financial or otherwise) to or from a third party;
- (c) The appointment of the Residential Caregiver does not represent any actual or perceived conflict of interest, and that any possible conflict of interest has been notified to One Tree Hill College;
- (d) The Residential Caregiver will take all reasonable steps to ensure the Student's compliance with New Zealand laws (including, where appropriate, informing the Student of such laws), and will immediately report any possible legal breach to One Tree Hill College; and
- (e) The Student only engages in lawful, responsible and positive recreational activities outside of One Tree Hill College.
- One Tree Hill College may take such measures as it considers appropriate (acting reasonably) to monitor compliance with the Code. This may include, without limitation, regular check-ins with both the Student and the Residential Caregiver.

Expectations

- The Student will comply at all times with the Accommodation Requirements and the Parents shall work with One Tree Hill College to ensure such compliance.
- In the event that the Student is removed from a Residential Caregiver for any reason, One Tree Hill College will take all reasonable steps to source, over a reasonable period of time (as determined by One Tree Hill College in its absolute discretion), appropriate alternative approved Accommodation for the Student.

Fees

 The Parents must pay all accommodation fees to One Tree Hill College in accordance with One Tree Hill College's fee schedule.

Termination

- One Tree Hill College reserves the right to terminate this Agreement if the Student is in breach of the Accommodation Requirements.
- Where this Agreement is terminated, fees may be refunded in accordance with One Tree Hill College Policies.

General

- This Agreement shall be construed and take effect in accordance with the non-exclusive laws of New Zealand. In relation to any legal action or proceedings arising out of or in connection with this Agreement, the Parents irrevocably:
 - (a) submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of New Zealand; and
 - (b) agree that proceedings may be brought before any Court including any forum constituted under the Arbitration Act 1908 within New Zealand, and waive any objection to proceedings in any such Court or forum on the grounds of venue or on the grounds that the proceedings have been brought in an inconvenient forum.
- Notices given under this Agreement must be in writing and given to the addresses set out in the Application Form. Those sent by post will be deemed to have been received ten (10) days after posting. The Parties agree that email correspondence is a suitable means of communication and emails will be deemed to have been received when acknowledged by the party or by return email.
- This Agreement contains the entire understanding of the parties and overrides any prior promises, representations, understandings or agreements.
- The parties acknowledge that prior to signing this Agreement, they have had the opportunity to seek independent legal advice in respect of its content and effect.

Disputes

The parties agree that any dispute in relation to this Agreement will be resolved in accordance with the Code and One Tree Hill College Policies.

Execution

This Agreement may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which when so executed and all of which together shall constitute one and the same Agreement. Delivery of the executed counterparts may be delivered by email or facsimile transmission.



HOMESTAY SCHEDULE

(Accommodation Requirements)

If the student is under the age of 20 years, this contract must be signed by a parent or legal guardian.

While living with a Homestay approved by One Tree Hill College, the Student agrees:

- To comply with all laws of New Zealand including those relating to the consumption of alcohol, cigarettes and illegal substances
- 2. That in accordance with Immigration New Zealand regulations, students will not seek employment while holding a student visa unless they have a variation of conditions to their permit
- 3. To not engage in any social or leisure activities that may place them in undue danger or risk of harm. I understand that my son/daughter must have a comprehensive medical and travel insurance policy during their time in NZ. It is recommended that students choose a policy that will also cover the loss of personal items
- 4. To obtain written permission from Parents and One Tree Hill College prior to obtaining any tattoo, piercing or other bodily embellishments
- 5. To not drive a motor vehicle except for the purposes of gaining a valid New Zealand driving license under the guidance of a licensed driving instructor. I understand students under the age of 20 years are not permitted to own a car while attending One Tree Hill College unless strict procedures are followed. Students over 20 must see the International Office to get information regarding driving in New Zealand if they are considering buying a car
- 6. To comply with all Homestay rules, expectations and curfews set by One Tree Hill College and Homestay parents. I understand that while in the care of One Tree Hill College students must abide by New Zealand law, the rules and regulations of the school, host family and homestay rules.
- 7. To not use or apply hair dyes or smoke cigarettes or engage in any other activity that may cause damage to the home or property at the Homestay
- 8. To keep the Homestay parents informed of their whereabouts at all times.
- 9. To not travel outside the local area of One Tree Hill College without prior written permission of the school. I understand that, if the student goes away on holiday for one week or more, they will pay \$70 per week as a holding fee for every week that they are away. This fee is for storage of their belongings and the holding of the room. This payment shall be made in advance
- 10. To respect the privacy, values and property of the Homestay. I guarantee the acceptable behaviour of the student in New Zealand. - 1. The Parents agree that the Designated Caregiver will provide residential care for the Student while enrolled as an international student at One Tree Hill College. I/We agree to permit One Tree Hill College to determine that the accommodation is not a boarding establishment. If it is, to follow the appropriate provisions as set out in the Education (Pastoral care of International Students) Code of Practice 2016 (the Code).
- One Tree Hill College has provided, and the Designated Caregiver has read and understood, the sections of the Education (Pastoral Care of International Students) Code of Practice 2016 (the Code) relevant to residential caregivers and the Information for Residential Caregivers booklet and agrees to act as Designated Caregiver to the Student in accordance with these requirements.
- One Tree Hill College agrees that all information regarding the Designated Caregiver relating to the Agreement will be kept confidential, except disclosure to the Student or their parents or their legal guardians, to any professional consultant or such person where it is in the interests of the Student to provide the information or pursuant to any statutory or other legal duty.
- 4. I/We agree to permit One Tree Hill College to undertake a police vet of the caregiver.
- 5. Approval is required from One Tree Hill College prior to the Student's placement with the Designated Caregiver. I/We agree to permit One Tree Hill College to visit the home of the designated caregiver prior to enrolment to determine that the living conditions are of a suitable standard.

- 6. The Designated Caregiver agrees that approval will be provided only after appropriate safety and other checks have been completed by One Tree Hill College in accordance with the Code and school policies. I/We agree to permit One Tree Hill College to assess that the caregiver will provide a safe physical and emotional environment for the student.
- 7. Failure by the Designated Caregiver to provide the residential care required by One Tree Hill College and the Code may result in the school's approval of the Designated Caregiver being withdrawn.

Act means the Education Act 1989.

Fee means fees payable by the Parents or Legal Guardians to One Tree Hill College as per the Fee Schedule.

Fee Schedule means the schedule of fees for Tuition, Accommodation and miscellaneous charges.

Homestay has the meaning as set out in the Code.

Parents or Legal Guardians means the parents or legal guardians referred to in the annexed Application Form.

Residential Caregiver has the meaning as set out in the Code.

School means the school referred to in the annexed Application Form.

Student means the student referred to in the annexed Application Form.

Tuition means the education of the Student at One Tree Hill College.

Period of Study means any period for which Fees are paid and for the purpose of this Agreement the enrolment of the Student begins on the course start date stated in the Student's offer of place and ends on the course end date stated in the Student's offer of place.

 One Tree Hill College shall provide Tuition to the Student in accordance with school policies, the Code, the Act and any other applicable laws, in return for the payment of the Fee.

The Parents or Legal Guardians and Student agree that no changes to accommodation arrangements will be made whatsoever without the prior written agreement of One Tree Hill College. The Parents or Legal Guardians will notify One Tree Hill College of any change of address or contact details. Any changes to this agreement must be done by written agreement from the Parents or Legal Guardians or One Tree Hill College.

The Parents or Legal Guardians and Student agree to comply with the immigration requirements as set out in the Immigration Act 2009, and any immigration conditions applicable to the Student's stay in New Zealand. The Parents or Legal Guardians and Student understand that One Tree Hill College has an obligation to report any breaches of the immigration requirements to the appropriate immigration authority.

The Parents or Legal Guardians and the Student agree that this Agreement is subject to an Accommodation Agreement or Designated Caregiver Agreement being entered into by all relevant parties.

The Fee must be paid to One Tree Hill College in advance of each Period of Study or as otherwise directed by One Tree Hill College. The Parents or Legal Guardians and the Student agree to comply with school policies regarding the payment of the Fee. All fees paid to One Tree Hill College are protected by the Fee Protection policy of One Tree Hill College.

 The agreement may be terminated at any time by the Parents or Legal Guardians or One Tree Hill College. The notice of termination must be in writing. If Tuition is terminated by One Tree Hill College during a Period of Study, in accordance with the Act and the Code, any refund of the Fee applicable to that Period of Study will be assessed in accordance with school policies. - One Tree Hill College shall provide help, support and guidance to the Student during their study at the school. One Tree Hill College will use its best efforts to ensure the safety, health and wellbeing of the Student while at One Tree Hill College.
- One Tree Hill College will provide homestay accommodation as per request. One Tree Hill College will use its best efforts to ensure that the homestay accommodation meets the student's needs.
- One Tree Hill College will provide regular reports of progress of the Student to the parents and the Student's agent.
- The Parents or Legal Guardians and the Student, who have signed this Agreement irrevocably appoint and authorise the principal of One Tree Hill College (or such other person as may be appointed by One Tree Hill College to carry out the principal's duties) to:
 - (a) Receive information from any person, authority, or corporate body concerning the Student including, but not limited to, medical, educational, financial or welfare information:
 - (b) Provide consents that may be necessary to be given on the Student's behalf in the event of a medical emergency where it is not reasonably practicable to contact the Parents or Legal Guardians;
 - (c) Enforce disciplinary provisions as according to the Act.
- The Parents or Legal Guardians irrevocably authorise the principal of One Tree Hill College to advise the Residential Caregiver (whether or not arranged through the school) of all matters and information required to be provided to the Parents or Legal Guardians and agree to appoint the Residential Caregiver in New Zealand to receive such information in substitution for the Parents or Legal Guardians.
- The Parents or Legal Guardians agree to provide One Tree Hill College with academic, medical or other information relating to the wellbeing of the Student as may be requested from time to time by One Tree Hill College. This includes notification of any learning disabilities. If the Parents or Legal Guardians provide misleading information or fail to disclose information about the Student to One Tree Hill College, such that One Tree Hill College has to change or modify the level of Tuition or Accommodation required by the Student, One Tree Hill College may charge the Parent or Legal Guardians such fees as required to adequately compensate for such additional requirements.
- The Parents or Legal Guardians agree that it is a condition of enrolment that the Student has current and comprehensive travel and medical insurance for their travel and study period. If requested, the Parents or Legal Guardians will provide One Tree Hill College with evidence of the relevant insurance policy. Agreement shall continue in force during the Year of Study with One Tree Hill College.

- 15. One Tree Hill College shall at all times comply with the Health and Safety at Work Act 2015.
- 16. Nothing in this Agreement limits any rights that the Parents, Legal Guardians or Student may have under the Consumer Guarantees Act 1993 and the Fair Trading Act 1986.
- 17. It is acknowledged that provisions in the Act relating to the suspension, expulsion or exclusion of students will apply to the Student while in New Zealand. Any decision to expel or exclude the Student shall terminate this Agreement and One Tree Hill College's refund policy will apply.
- The Student will comply at all times with school policies, the Code and the Act, and the Parents or Legal Guardians shall work with One Tree Hill College to ensure such compliance.
- No party to this Agreement is liable to the other for failing to meet its obligations under this Agreement to the extent that the failure was caused by an act of God or other circumstances beyond its reasonable control. While One Tree Hill College will do its best to ensure the safety, health and wellbeing of the Student, One Tree Hill College is not liable for any damage or harm caused to a student or to a student's property inside or outside of school hours. The school's liability in relation to tuition services is limited to the mount of tuition fees paid by the Student.
- This Agreement shall be construed and take effect in accordance with the non-exclusive laws of New Zealand. In relation to any legal action or proceedings arising out of or in connection with this Agreement the Parents or Legal Guardians irrevocably:
 - (a) Submit to the non-exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts of New Zealand; and
 - (b) Agree that proceedings may be brought before any Court including any forum constituted under the Arbitration Act 1908 within New Zealand, and waive any objection to proceedings in any such Court or forum on the grounds of venue or on the grounds that the proceedings have been brought in an inconvenient forum.
- Notices given under this Agreement must be in writing and given to the addresses set out in the Application Form. Those notices sent by post will be deemed to have been received ten (10) days after posting. The Parties also agree that email correspondence is a suitable means of communication and emails will be deemed to have been received when acknowledged by the party or by return email.
- This Agreement contains the entire understanding of the parties and overrides any prior promises, representations, understandings or agreements. The terms of the Agreement may be changed by One Tree Hill College in consultation with the Student, and Parents or Legal Guardians, except where such change is required by New Zealand legislation or the Code. This Agreement shall continue in force during the Year of Study with One Tree Hill College.

- 23. The Parents or Legal Guardians and Student acknowledge that:
 - (a) One Tree Hill College may obtain at any time from any person or entity any information it requires to process and/or accept the Student for admission to One Tree Hill College or to perform or complete any of the other purposes under this Agreement. The Parents or Legal Guardians and the Student authorise any such person to release to One Tree Hill College any personal information that person holds concerning the Student and/or Parents or Legal Guardians.
 - (b) If the Student and/or Parents or Legal Guardians fail to provide any information requested in relation the Students admission to One Tree Hill College, One Tree Hill College may be unable to process the Student's application.
 - (c) This Agreement is conditional at all times on the Student having accommodation in New Zealand which complies with the Code. If this condition is unable to remain fulfilled, than this Agreement will be at an end.
 - (d) Personal information of the Student and/or Parents or Legal Guardians collected or held by One Tree Hill College is provided and may be held, used and disclosed to enable One Tree Hill College to process the Student's eligibility to receive Tuition at One Tree Hill College and Accommodation.
 - (e) All personal information provided to One Tree Hill College is collected and will be held by One Tree Hill College.
 - (f) The Student and Parents or Legal Guardians have the right under the Privacy Act 1993 to obtain access to and request corrections of any personal information held by One Tree Hill College concerning them.
 - (g) Under the Privacy Act 1993, any information collected may be provided to education authorities.
 - (h) Students' rights under the Privacy Act 1993 allow them to ask for confidential help from health and guidance counsellors. This may include advice on contraception.
 - (i) Information relating to the education, health, welfare or safety of the Student, may be released to relevant parties outside One Tree Hill College, at the discretion of One Tree Hill College.
 - (j) The Student is subject to the conditions of enrolment for International students, as set out in the prospectus and application for of One Tree Hill College.
 - (k) One Tree Hill College has the right to direct the Student in their academic course and subject choices using their best judgement and experience.
 - One Tree Hill College has the authority to permit the student to participate in extra school activities and school trips.

- (c) The student will follow any reasonable instruction given by a teacher.
- (n) The Student will not own or drive a car while at One Tree Hill College unless they have followed the driving and car ownership procedures. The Student will not travel in a car driven by a driver who is unauthorized to drive under school policy or under New Zealand law.
- (o) The parents will give written permission if their child intends to travel in New Zealand during holiday periods. One Tree Hill College reserves the right to override the parent's decision if the child's health and safety is at risk and there is inadequate supervision on the trip. Travel to destinations other than in New Zealand will be treated as travel in New Zealand. Students younger than 18 will not be allowed to travel unsupervised. Parents will ensure that their child will not extend holidays beyond the regulated dates.
- 24. Photographs and videos of the Student may be used for the Student's records and in any publicity material for One Tree Hill College.
- One Tree Hill College responsibility for the Student ends on the last day of the Period of Study, or in the event that the Student's Tuition is terminated, on the date of termination.
- The conditions in this Agreement apply for the whole time the Student is enrolled at One Tree Hill College during a Period of Study. - The parties agree that any dispute in relation to this Agreement will be resolved in accordance with the Code and One Tree Hill College Policies.

Refund Conditions for International Students

This policy should be read in conjunction with the Education (Pastoral Care of International Students) Code of Practice 2016 and the Education Act 1989 (section 4B (7) of the Educational Amendment (No 4) Act 1991).

Requests for Refund of International Student Fees

The school will consider requests for a refund of International Student fees provided the request is made in writing to the school within twelve months after the final enrolment date of the student.

A request for a refund must set out the circumstances leading to the refund, name the person requesting the refund, name the person who paid the fees, provide a bank account to receive any eligible refund and provide any relevant supporting documentation.

Refund of Tuition Fees

1. Requests for a refund for failure to obtain a study visa

If an International Student fails to obtain an appropriate study visa, a refund of International Student tuition fees will be provided less an administration and enrolment fee of \$1000.00.

2. Voluntary withdrawal

- a. If your application for a refund is made before the start of your study, your fees will be refunded in full, less the administration and enrolment charge of \$1000.00 to cover costs incurred.
- b. If a student withdraws after the start of their study time, no refund will be made except where the student returns home due to a serious illness or the serious illness of a close family member. Study time encompasses the period that has been paid for and is irrespective of the date the student wishes to withdraw.
 - In that event the refund will be calculated in accordance with paragraph 3. Immigration New Zealand will be notified of the student's need to return home.
 - In every case the school undertakes to look fairly at applications for a refund of fees or part-fees.
- 3. If a student withdraws from a subject, course or programme and is eligible for a refund, the \$1000.00 administration and enrolment fee will be retained and the following deductions will apply:
- Costs to the school already incurred for your time at the school. This includes tuition fees and costs already incurred for the use of facilities and resources.
- Components of the fee already committed for the duration of the course, including appropriate proportions of salaries of teachers and support staff (if applicable).
- The proportion of the Government Levy that the school is required to pay.
- Any other costs already incurred. This would include commission paid to an agent.

4. Requests for a refund for failure to provide a course, cessation as a signatory or cessation to be a provider

If the school fails to provide the agreed course of education or is no longer a signatory to the Code or no longer operates as an international education provider, the school will negotiate with the student or their family to either:

- Refund the unused portion of International Student tuition fees or other fees paid for services not delivered or
- · Transfer the amount of any eligible refund to another provider

5. No refunds will be made:

- To a student who is required to leave the school for a breach of the rules and conditions of enrolment at the school or has broken a New Zealand law.
- To a student who acquires permanent residence or a domestic student status visa.
- To a student who wants to transfer to another school or educational institution.
- To a student who returns home for any reason other than the student's serious illness or serious illness
 of a close family member.



- 6. The Board of Trustees and Principal have ultimate discretion in any decisions made regarding refunds.
- 7. You must write a letter to the Principal of the school explaining why you have withdrawn from the course and your reasons for seeking a refund. You must also complete the official leaving process and attach the leaving certificate.
- 8. All refunds will be paid to either the parents of the student or to an agent with written authority from the parents. No refunds will be given directly to the student.
- 9. The school has a fee protection policy to safeguard the fees paid by International Students.

Homestay Fees (Based on all homestay fees paid in advance)

- 1. If you move out of your homestay before the end of your contract the portion of your homestay fees not already used will be returned to your parents, or to the agent appointed by your parents. The homestay placement fee of \$300 will not be refunded. The administration fee will not be refunded for partial terms. The administration fee will only be refunded for full unused terms.
- 2. To have your homestay fees returned you must have completed the leaving process at school and given two weeks' notice to the Homestay Coordinator, or pay two weeks fees in lieu of notice.

Outstanding Activity Fees or Other Fees

Any activity or other fees incurred by a student during enrolment and unpaid at the time of withdrawal, will be deducted from any eligible refund
