The OTHC Music department offers lessons for the following instruments:

Lesson places are limited, with priority first going to Year 11, 12 and 13 students completing NCEA performance assessments and students contributing to our extra-curricular ensemble groups.

Students who are provided a place in the ITM lesson programme are to understand that such a placement is a privilege, and are expected to attend all of their scheduled lessons. Failure to commit to their lessons will result in their place being given to another student.

Choirs

One Tree Hill is very proud of its achievements in the realm of choral music. Students of all year levels are encouraged to participate in one of our award winning choirs. Every year both of our premiere choirs enter the national Big Sing Competition, with our premiere male choir having qualified for the national final on multiple occasions

Orchestra

Students of brass, string, woodwind and percussion are encouraged to join our Concert Band, which performs each year at the KBB Music Festival, as well as contributing to several in-school performance dates including the end of year prize-giving ceremonies.

Jazz Ensemble

Our Jazz Ensemble also takes part in the annual KBB Music Festival, and is active multiple performance opportunities throughout the year.

Contemporary Music

Whether soloists, duets, or full ensemble rock bands, students with a passion for contemporary music and song-writing are encouraged to perform in the Rockquest, Tagata Beats, The Play it Strange Song Writing Competition, and Stand Up Stand Out. Contemporary ensembles are student led for the most part, but will receive support from the music staff where available, and committed ensembles will be given scheduled rehearsal bookings in the rehearsal suites where available.
