Dear Parents and Caregivers

I would like to thank parents and caregivers who attended our recent Parent/Teacher Interviews. We value your involvement in your child's learning and cannot overemphasise the importance of home support in helping your child achieve the best outcomes possible. I received numerous comments on how happy and welcoming the atmosphere at One Tree Hill College is, as well as the positive leadership of the Prefects.

Last week, the winter sports season began for most sporting codes. It was wonderful to see our students enjoying themselves playing a variety of sports. A special congratulations to the following teams:

- 1st XV Girls Rugby 2 wins, including 1 against last year's champions

UNIFORM

A reminder that students should all be wearing the correct school uniform and substitute items are not allowed. All boys must be clean shaven. Please also remind your child that apart from one small sleeper or stud per ear, no other jewellery is permitted.

BEFORE AND AFTER SCHOOL

We ask that students do not arrive at school before 8am. We require all students to have moved off the school grounds by 3:45pm to make their way directly home, unless they are involved in other school activities. There is to be no congregating on school grounds or in the community. Please remember there is no dropping-off/picking-up of students inside the school grounds. Please arrange for a drop-off/pick-up point somewhere off Rockfield Road. For safety reasons do not stop outside the school gates, or on yellow lines, as this may cause accidents.
