### Principal's Message



#### **Dear Parents and Caregivers**

Congratulations to former student David Liti for placing 5<sup>th</sup> at the Tokyo Olympics in the +109kg weightlifting category, achieving a new personal best in the clean and jerk of 236kg, with a 178kg lift in the snatch, to post an overall weight of 414kg. We are all very proud of him.

Commencing Monday 16 August, we will begin issuing a weekly engagement report for all Year 9 students. In Term 4, this will extend to all Year 10 students, with the engagement reports being issued to all levels next year. These reports will be emailed to parents/caregivers at the end of each week providing feedback on a student's attendance and engagement. As noted above, on Thursday 19 August we will be holding our Achievement Interview Day (previously called Parent Teacher Interviews). It is important that every family books time to meet with their child's teacher, using the on-line booking system, so that we are working together to enhance your child's learning. The expectation is that every child will attend the interview with

their parents/caregivers in their full school uniform. At the interview you will be able to enquire about your child's learning, as well as receive feedback from their teachers. Early next week, all parents/caregivers will receive an email detailing the booking instructions and other information about this very important day.

On Friday 13 August, One Tree Hill College will be holding its annual Flight Dance Showcase. The Flight Dance Showcase is a collection of performances by dance students, which count towards NCEA Dance assessments. Year 13 students are required to do choreographies and performances around the theme of Haikus and Turangawaewae – A Place of Belonging. Year 10, 11 and 12 students will be performing in dance groups. The dance styles will be Contemporary, Contemporary Pasifika, Jazz, Hip Hop and Bollywood. Flight Dance Showcase is being held in the Marilyn Wales Auditorium from 6-7pm. Entry is by gold coin donation.

Finally, our biennial Careers Expo will be taking place on Wednesday 11 August in the school auditorium. At One Tree Hill College we are very fortunate to have an exceptional careers team who are experts at supporting and guiding our students into strong future pathways. The careers staff have assembled over 40 different tertiary and employment training providers to be available during the afternoon to discuss the many available options with students and families. Senior students will be scheduled to visit the Careers Expo during the school day. Junior students can attend during lunchtime or afterschool.
