Dear Parents and Caregivers

After not having students onsite at One Tree Hill College since 17 August, it has been wonderful to see them return recently. Year 11, 12 and 13 students have really made the most of being back in classrooms, and I would like to acknowledge the responsible and respectful manner in which they have returned. With many new health and safety requirements now in place, everyone has really played their part to keep us all safe.


NEW ARTIFICAL TURF AT OTHC
